1.12 1931-32 A.E.C. Renown 664

The 6-wheel A.E.C. Renown 664 was introduced in 1930 with a wheelbase of 18ft 3in and a 6-cylinder 7.4 litre petrol engine. It was in production until 1940 and a total of 346 were produced in both single and double deck versions. Red & White acquired three with the Imperial Motors business in 1937.
