1.6 1931/35 Albion Victor

The Albion Victor PH49 which was introduced in 1930 was designed as a normal control chassis for 20 seats to replace the PH24. About 100 were built between 1931 and 1934. The single Red & White purchase, with a 14ft 6in wheelbase and 3.15 litre 4-cylinder Albion engine, was demonstrated at the 1931 Olympia show. The Victor 115 introduced in 1934 was a forward control chassis with a new 3.89 litre 4-cylinder engine. The PK115 had a 16ft 4in wheelbase and was produced between 1934 and 1939. The Red & White vehicle was new to Gorseinon & District in 1935 and was acquired with the company in 1938.
